Bouncy Castle Policy

Anyone wishing to hire a Bouncy Castle to be used in the Church Hall or Church Grounds must agree to abide by the following policy:

- 1 There must be a minimum of two adults supervising the castle at all times.
- 2 You must read and comply with all safety instructions supplied with the castle.
- 3 A limit should be set and not exceeded according to the size of the castle for the number of children allowed on at any one time. This may have been set by the hire company.
- 4 Only allow children of similar abilities on the castle at all times. Older children may accompany small children where they are helping the younger child to enjoy the experience.
- 5 Over exuberant children are not necessarily badly behaved, but should be asked to leave the castle where there is a risk of injury to others. They could, perhaps, be asked to return later to enjoy themselves.
- 6 Castles in the Church grounds may not be used when wet as there is a greater danger of injury.
- 7 Please ensure that you have insurance cover for the use of the castle. This may be included in the hire charge.
